



1. Romans 3:23 (NKJV) For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. - *There is no one without sin, and no one who is perfect, except God. He is without sin, and He is perfect.*
2. Romans 3:10 (NKJV) As it is written. there is none righteous, no, not one; - *There is no one who is morally good on his own and accepted by God. Your good works may get God's attention but won't give you a pass.*
3. Romans 5:12 (NKJV) Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all have sinned. - *When Adam disobeyed God in the beginning, sin entered the world and spread to all men. Because of this sin, all are equally deserving of death and need a Savior.*
4. Romans 6:23 (NKJV) For the wages of sin [is] death, but the gift of God [is] eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. - *The punishment for sin is eternal death and separation from God. No matter how good a person may think he or she is, their work can never be good enough. But there's a gift of eternal life that God extends to us so that we don't have to pay the price of that sin, and that is through faith in Jesus Christ, his son.*
5. Romans 5:8 (NKJV) But God demonstrates his own love towards us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. *Because of our sin, we deserved death, but Jesus Christ took the judgment for our sin on Himself. Over two thousand years ago He suffered and died a painful and undeserving death in our place on a cross, knowing we would need this redemption one day. It takes love to die willingly for someone else, even if they're a "good" person. He died for us before we'd ever done anything to deserve that love, and He proved His love for us by laying down his life.*
6. Romans 10:9-10 (NKJV) That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and Believe in your heart that God has raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart, one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. - *This is the key to being saved and declared righteous (in good standing and accepted) by God. Believe in your heart that Jesus was raised from the dead and make a verbal declaration that He is "Lord of all". This is the 1st step to show that you are putting your trust in Jesus Christ alone for eternal life.*

7. Romans 10:13 (NKJV) For whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. - When you repent of your sins and you put your hope and trust in Jesus, asking Him to be the Lord of your life, and you mean it with all your heart, you will be saved, and you will be a part of God's family for eternity. Will you pray this prayer with me to ask Jesus to be the Lord of your life today?

Dear Jesus, I believe that you are the Son of God and that you didn't deserve to be punished and crucified in my place. I understand that it's my sin that sentenced me to death, and the only way to be saved is by believing that you gave your life to be put to death so that I didn't have to pay that price. You loved me and did it because there was no other way. Jesus, please forgive me of all my sins and be the Lord of my life today. I receive your gift of eternal life. Thank you for saving me.
